

Stakeholder Cancer Rehabilitation Research Study Introductory Script

Researchers at the University of Pittsburgh are studying how cancer rehabilitation services are created and delivered to older adult breast cancer survivors. As part of the research study, we are seeking volunteers who are willing to complete a one-time questionnaire and interview. The questionnaire will ask you about your past medical history and experiences with cancer rehabilitation and take 5 minutes to complete. The interview will take no more than 60 minutes, take place over the phone, and discuss your history of cancer-related disability, experience cancer rehabilitation, and preferences for rehabilitation services. You will be compensated for your participation in the study.

If you are willing to participate, I will pass along your name and phone number to the principal investigator on the research team. You will be contacted by the investigator to complete a brief telephone screening to ensure your eligibility. If eligible, you will then complete informed consent and schedule a time to complete the questionnaire and interview. You will be assigned unique study ID. All data collections are confidential and will be kept under password protection. Your participation is voluntary, and you may refuse assessment completion at any time.
