Dear CARG Members,

As many of you know, the Cancer and Aging Research Group (CARG) has received continued support from a National Institute on Aging R21/R33 grant to develop a national infrastructure in the US for geriatric oncology research (MPIs: Dale, Mohile, Klepin). This infrastructure will be developed through 7 dedicated Cores [Leadership, Aging Measures, Clinical Implementation, Supportive Care, Health Services, Analytics, and Communication] that will serve as a central resource of available expertise and propel high-impact, interdisciplinary, collaborative research in geriatric oncology.

A vital component of this infrastructure is a Junior Faculty Advisory Board (Co-Chairs: Magnuson, Li, Sedrak). Members of this board participate in each of the infrastructure Cores, providing critical input from the junior faculty perspective. **We are seeking two early career investigators** to add additional members to serve on the Supportive Care Core.

As a member of the Junior Faculty Board, you would be expected to attend a quarterly Junior Faculty Board Planning call, participate in Junior Faculty mentoring activities (e.g. mentoring sessions on main CARG call), participate in assigned Infrastructure Core activities, and attend an in-person/virtual CARG Infrastructure meeting.

Please note, this opportunity is limited to individuals who have completed fellowship training and have a faculty appointment (Instructor or Assistant Professor rank) at a U.S.-based institution.
